GOAL I.

The Storm Lake Community School District will research strategies to help improve student proficiencies and improve test scores in the areas of reading, math and science. On-going study and periodic reports will be made to the Board of Education relative to the strategies being used and the success of each.

- A. District in need of assistance goals.
 - Action 1. The district will establish clearly defined goals (targets) for student success.
 - Action 2. Continue training on SBRR strategies.
 - Action 3. Leadership fostering a unified system.
 - Action 4. Parent engagement.
- B. All students will score at or above the trajectory level for the school district and the state.
- C. All sub-groups of students who are currently below the district's and the state's trajectory level will make progress towards this goal thus helping close the achievement gap between groups.
- D. Support System for Students will be studied, continued and implemented for all grade levels. Programs to continue or to research for implementation include the following (but are not limited to the following):
 - a. Love & Logic training to include Before and After school personnel
 - b. Student Mentors
 - c. Parental Involvement Groups-- Citizen Advisory, ELL, Migrant and Other Parent Meetings conducted in different languages.
 - d. ELL Best Practice
 - e. Poverty Awareness for staff members
 - f. Continue Research into Other Support Systems for Students by use of Professional Learning Community (PLC).
 - g. Advancement Via Individual Determination (AVID)
 - h. Response to Intervention (RTI)
