**GOAL I.**

The Storm Lake Community School District will research strategies to help improve student proficiencies and improve test scores in the areas of reading, math and science. On-going study and periodic reports will be made to the Board of Education relative to the strategies being used and the success of each.

- A. All students will score at or above the trajectory level for the school district and the state.
- B. All sub-groups of students who are currently below the district's and the state's trajectory level will make progress towards this goal thus helping close the achievement gap between groups.
- C. Support System for Students will be studied, continued and implemented for all grade levels.
  - 1. Programs to continue or to research for implementation include the following (but are not limited to the following):
    - a. Love & Logic—continue activity at the middle school, **continue implementation at the elementary and begin implementation at the high school.**
    - b. Student Mentors
    - c. Parental Involvement Groups
    - d. Bi-Lingual Education Models
    - e. Special Programs in the Elementary as we transition to one building K-4
    - f. **Poverty Awareness training for ALL staff members**
    - g. **Continue Research into Other Support Systems for Students (Ideas to consider taken from book study of "Whatever It Takes"**
    - h. K-12 TAG (Mid-Year report where we are in comparison to other schools.)
