Breakfast Buddies

Greet the students who are attending breakfast at an elementary school with a friendly smile, positive thoughts and caring actions. Learn their names and encourage good eating habits. Approximately 7:45-8:30 am, Monday through Friday. Pick a morning(s) that works for you!

Rockin' Readers

This is program designed to help students (K-2) who need assistance with reading and/or listening skills – or maybe just need some special attention during the school day. Volunteers commit to ½ hour a week on a regular schedule.

Connections Mentoring Program

Volunteers are asked to commit one hour a week (for a school year) to being a special friend to a student (K-8th grade). Activities may include playing games, assisting with homework, reading together, etc. This program takes place during the after school program between 3:30-6:00 pm at the child's school.

Adventure Club

This event is scheduled on early dismissal days to provide a safe and structured environment for K-4th grade students. Activities are planned by staff and include games, crafts, field trips, swimming, roller-skating, etc. Adventure Clubs are scheduled for Oct. 16-27-29, Nov. 13, Feb. 26, Mar.12-23-25, Apr 23, May 7.
