

GRADE CLASSIFICATION

*This section answers the question:
“How do I know what grade I am in?”*

Class of 2011 and beyond:

Sophomore: To be considered a Sophomore (10th grade), a student has to have 12 credits at the beginning of the academic school year (8/1/).

Junior: To be considered a Junior (11th grade), a student has to have 24 credits at the beginning of the academic school year (9/1).

Senior: To be considered a Senior (12th grade), a student has to have 36 credits at the beginning of the academic school year (9/1).

Students within 2 credits of this requirement may be allowed to advance to the next grade level. These situations will be looked at on an individual basis.

Remember, in High School, you need to pass your classes in order to receive credits. You need to receive credits in order to pass on to the next grade. If you get behind on credits, it will take you LONGER than 4 years to get your Storm Lake High School Diploma.
