## THE PEARL HULL FALK SCHOLARSHIP GENERAL INFORMATION

### BACKGROUND

MidWestOne Bank (formerly Iowa State Bank & Trust Company) administers the Pearl Hull Falk Trust that provides funds for the Pearl Hull Falk Scholarship. Prior to her death in 1965, Pearl Hull Falk resided in Iowa City where her husband was a prominent banker during the early 1900's. The trust was established under the Last Will and Testament of Mrs. Falk to provide annual scholarships to needy and worthy students attending the University of Iowa.

### AWARDS

Between 80 and 90 scholarships are awarded annually in the amount of \$400.00 each. The scholarship funds are paid directly to the students in installments of \$200.00 at the beginning of each semester.

### REQUIREMENTS

Each recipient of the Pearl Hull Falk Scholarship must be:

1. of the Protestant faith,
2. a resident of the State of Iowa, and
3. a full-time student at the University of Iowa

At least one of the recipients must be a member of an Episcopal Church, and at least one must be a young man who shows interest in and promise for a career in banking. All recipients must be of good character and have a good scholastic record.

### HOW TO APPLY

All applicants must complete a *Pearl Hull Falk Scholarship Application*. The Application form and supporting materials must be submitted to the Scholarship Committee no later than May 1<sup>st</sup>. All applicants will be notified by mail of their award status by July 31<sup>st</sup>.
